# LAST DAY 2018 and FIRST DAY 2019

Monday is the official last day of school. As has been a tradition at Roto-o-Rangi School for many years now we ask that parents of children with Year 1-5 children keep them at home on the last day so that just our Year 6 students turn up to school.

As a treat for all the extra tasks and responsibilities they undertake in the school over their last 2 years, we like to give them the run of the school, uninterrupted, on our last day (plus there is an all in waterfight between some staff and the Year 6s). They also do quite a bit of sorting of school resources, cleaning and helping teachers with their classrooms. We hope that you will continue to support our little tradition.

It is still an official school day, therefore we cannot require any students to stay home on the last day. If your child/ren really do need to come to school because there are no alternatives for them, then of course they come to school. Another request for the last day is that all children are picked up between 12 and 12.30pm.

Both buses will stop operating on Friday (tomorrow), so children will get to and from school on tomorrow but there will be **no buses on Monday**.

We will begin 2019 with a Whakatau (modified powhiri), to welcome any new staff, students and families to the school. So, all of the family who are new to the school are invited to be a part of the Whakatau and be officially welcomed into the Roto-o-Rangi School whanau.

The new children and adults will come into the school and wait just inside the front gates. Curent families enter as normal. We will hold the whakatau at 9.00am on **Thursday 31st January, 2019; our first day of school in 2019.**

Tonight we conclude the formal end of the year with our Prizegiving Assembly in the Roto-o-Rangi Hall at 7pm. Children from each class are acknowledged for a year of ako, mahi and Taonga Horomata (learning, work and Values).

#### 2019 MLA Homestay Placements Required

Roto-o-Rangi School is one of the Cambridge Fusion cluster of schools which has been developing Mandarin learning from Year 3 right through to High School, and in 2019 will have Mandarin offered at NCEA Level 1 for the very first time ever.

As part of Cambridge Fusion we have been able to have Mandarin Language Assistants (*MLAs* – postgraduate university students who are training to become teachers of English in China. They go through an intensive process to be selected for the MLA programme, including police vetting). In 2019 there will be 2 MLAs supporting us and the other Cambridge Fusion schools.

We are looking for two long-term homestay placements for these young student teachers from Friday 1 February, 2019 to the end of Term 4, 2019. Fees of \$250.00 per week will be paid to homestay hosts to cover expenses.
